Code of Conduct for Parents/Guardians/Carers/Spectators

Norwich Dragons Hockey Club encourages parents/guardians/spectators to take an active interest in their child or vulnerable person's development within hockey and ask that every parent/guardian/spectator observe the following:

- Never force them to take part in sport
- Encourage them to learn the rules and play within them
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials, please publicly accept officials' judgements
- Support their involvement and help them to understand that the enjoyment of sport and fair play are more important than winning
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performances of all to help them to recognise good performance, not just results
- Never punish or belittle them for losing or making mistakes
- Use correct and proper language at all times
- During games or coaching sessions, please remain outside the pitch area to allow the coaches to manage the sessions
